92 James Suckling

La Sirène de Giscours 2017 | \$128

Medium garnet-purple in colour, with pretty kirsch and rose hip tea notes, core of red plums and hints of cloves and forest floor. Medium-bodied, chewy and fresh with a good core of fragrant fruit and an earthy finish.

Château Marquis d'Alesme Becker 2017 | \$150

Deep purple-black in colour with a gorgeous perfume of crème de cassis, black cherries, crushed violets, and cedary spice. Medium-bodied and intense with very firm, grainy tannins and fantastic freshness, finishing with great length and depth.

Château Du Tertre 2008 | \$180

Light blackberry and cedar aromas at first, followed by a hint of black olive and a light marine scent that gradually develops. Medium-bodied with supple tannin, well-judged acidity, touches of mulberry, spice box and clove with a slightly short finish.



92 Wine Enthusiast

Château d'Issan 2011 | \$198

Dark ruby-purple colour with a classic Margaux perfume of sweet blueberries, blackcurrants, spring flowers and liquorice. Ripe and deep with impressive intensity, silky tannins, fresh acids and stunning length.



91 Wine Enthusiast

Château Brane Cantenac 2016 | \$228

Deep purple colour with a very complex nose of black fruits, toast, vanilla, and floral and fresh notes. Supple and round palate, the tannic structure is fine and silky, and the finish persists with a very pleasant aromatic back palate.



96-98 Robert Parker

Château Giscours 2010 | \$248

Deep garnet in colour, with notions of baked black cherries, mulberries and plum preserves plus hints of cassis, pencil lead and dried Provence herbs. Medium to full-bodied, the palate is totting a fair amount of oak with a sturdy frame of chewy tannins, with a long and fruity finish.



95 Wine Enthusiast

Château Malescot St. Exupery 1999 | \$268

Medium ruby-red, with complex aromatics consisting of herbs, red and black fruits, minerals, acacia flowers, and liquorice. Medium to full-bodied, with firm, velvety tannins and a long finish.



90 Robert Parker

Pavillon Rouge Du Château Margaux 2009 | \$348

Medium to deep garnet coloured, with a very pure bouquet of blackberry, raspberry coulis, cedar and light violet aromas. Medium-bodied, the palate is soft, plush, elegant and open-knit with an effortlessness to its character and a perfumed finish.



93 Robert Parker

Château Palmer 1978 | \$780

Powerful, expressive nose with cedar, sous-bois and cigar-box scents interwoven into the vestiges of black fruit. The palate is medium-bodied and well balanced, hints of spice and cedar, a little dustiness perhaps towards the finish.



92 Robert Parker

Château Margaux 1998 | \$888

Dense ruby-purple, with gorgeous aromas of berry, currant and exotic spices, especially cinnamon. Medium to full-bodied, with layers of silky tannins and ripe berry and raspberry on the palate.
