Saint-Estèphe



Château Le Crock 2019 | \$128

Darker plums, currants, cedary spice and tobacco on the nose. Medium to full-bodied, structured and balanced with a solid mid-palate depth. Beautiful tannins and outstanding length.



Les Pagodes de Cos 2014 | \$158

A balanced and voluptuous wine with impressive and intense notes of plums, spices, mushrooms and black truffles. Full-bodied, firm with silky tannins and a savoury finish.



Les Marquis de Calon Segur 2011 | \$180

Dark ruby coloured with juicy black cherry aromas. Pleasant, light to medium-bodied with acidity and good texture. Plenty of flavour depth while tannins are firmly in the background.



Château Calon Segur 2005 | \$358

Beautiful nose of crushed berry, spices and nutmeg, with a hint of coffee and liquorice. Full-bodied, with super silky tannins and a long finish of vanilla, berry and cinnamon.



Château Montrose 1993 | \$438

Rich and elegant tobacco, cherry, smoke, toasted oak character. Palate is medium-bodied with firm, slightly rustic tannin. Long and flavourful on the finish.



Château Cos d'Estournel 2000 | \$498

Ripe currants, spicy wood, graphite, smoky tobacco, and cedar pencil notes on the nose. Rich and full-bodied, with a concentrated, layered mouthfeel, ripe, polished tannins, and a great, great finish.

Pessac-Léognan

Château Le Carmes Haut-Brion 2021 | \$198

A heady, racy wine with notes of tobacco, mocha, cedar, leather, dried herbs, menthol, liquorice and plum that saturate the palate. Medium-bodied, with a wonderful and impressive tannin texture that melts into the wine, giving softness and finesse.



Chapelle de La Mission Haut-Brion 2014 | \$228

Opens with a tannic texture that becomes soft and pleasantly fresh on the middle palate, displaying intense cherry aromas with a touch of cocoa on the nose. Lovely fruit flavours continue into a long finish.



30th Anniversary Limited Edition

Château Smith Haut Lafitte 2020 | \$298

Dark red, almost black with blueish hues. Expressive nose of red fruits and black fruits flavours, along with star anise, liquorice and hints of flint stone and empyreumatic notes. Wide and powerful, with a well-defined structure.



Château Bahans Haut-Brion 2000 | \$390

Complex notes of smoky, soft berry fruit and fresh porcini mushrooms intermixed with cigar tobacco and black currants. On the palate, it has ripe tannins, a balanced, layered mouthfeel, and outstanding length.



Château La Mission Haut-Brion 2020 | \$528

Aromas of dark berries and plums mingled with burning embers, pencil shavings, violets and smoked black tea. Full-bodied, deep and concentrated, with a layered, elegantly muscular profile.



Château Haut-Brion 2012 | \$798

Medium to deep garnet, leaping with vibrant blackcurrant cordial, preserved plums, tar, and liquorice scents, followed by touches of graphite, dried roses, and cardamom plus a hint of crushed rocks.
